ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN PERIODONTICS

The Faculty of Dental Medicine of the Université de Montréal is searching for a full-time assistant professor in periodontics with a strong interest (or background) in research.

Functions:

The selected candidate will assume the following tasks:

- Didactic, pre-clinical and clinical teaching of periodontics to undergraduate and graduate students;
- Conducting research in the field of periodontics;
- Supervising research of postgraduate students;
- Participating in collaboration with other team members in a preventive care clinic for adults (using a global treatment approach); providing initial periodontal care (scaling, root planing), periodontal surgical therapy and implant treatment;
- Contributing to the functioning of the Faculty of Dental Medicine and to the overall excellence of the Université de Montréal;
- Enhancing the University's reputation by sharing his or her scholarly work with the scientific community and with society at large.

Requirements:

1. Holder of a Masters (M.Sc.) or doctorate (Ph.D.) and a certificate in periodontics or having completed equivalent training;
2. Holder of, or able to obtain, a permit to practice dentistry from the Order of Dentists of Quebec;
3. Holder of, or eligible to obtain certification from the Royal College of Dentists of Canada in periodontics;
4. Fluency in French and a very good knowledge of English;
5. Having a good knowledge of teaching and motivational techniques;
6. Being able to direct, develop or be part of a clinical and/or basic research team and having demonstrated an ability to produce scientific articles.
