

*Prevention, Diagnosis and Treatment of Peri-implant Disease learning objectives:*

*This course is intended for clinicians who have been exposed to implants (peri-implantitis cases) and want to extend their expertise in this area of knowledge. Following this course the clinician should be able to demonstrate the following:*

- 1. The clinician should be able to assess and diagnose Peri-implantitis using the criteria given*
- 2. Be able to identify the different stages of implantitis and the appropriate treatment for each condition*
- 3. Be able to establish a custom continuing care program based on the peri-implantitis criteria with an emphasis on prevention*
- 4. Become comfortable with all the appropriate instrumentation for implant debridement and determine when they should be utilized*
- 5. Identify technologies that impact Peri-implantitis treatment and incorporate those technologies into your practice (PRF – Platelet Rich Fibrin, Laser detoxification, Digital scanning and custom abutment fabrication)*
